Instructions for filling out the Camping Registration Form

The 1) **Boogie Camping Form 2025** and 2) **Boogie Camping Instructions, Info, Fees 2025** are available on our website (<https://www.whitemountainboogie.com>)

- a. Download the two documents:
 - 1) **Boogie Camping Form 2025** and
 - 2) **Boogie Camping Instructions, Info, Fees 2025**Both are in PDF format, and can be opened with Adobe Acrobat Reader (or any other PDF reader you might use).

There is a sample Boogie Camping Form 2025 below. DO NOT fill this one in. Please fill in the Boogie Camping Form 2025 document.
 - b. Once the **Boogie Camping Form 2025** file is open, under Tools, use the Fill and Sign function. This will allow you to go into the form and click in a space and fill in the information.
 - c. After filling in the form, DON'T forget to SAVE the file with your name as the file name (ex. Jane Doe). IF you are filling in more than one Boogie Camping Form 2025, please add a number to the file name for each form you submit. (ex. Jane Doe 1, Jane Doe 2, Jane Doe 3.....)
2. The 2025 Camping Registration Form has 4 parts (see example form below):
 - Part A – Registration Info
 - Part B – Camping & Ticket Info
 - Part C – Payment Info
 - Part D – Email Info
 3. Please fill-out one **Boogie Camping Form 2025** per Site for either a Campground Numbered Site, or Field Site
 - IF THERE IS MORE THAN ONE Tent/Camper/RV per Site, a Camping Registration Form must be filled out for each Tent/Camper/RV on that Site
 - Also, should you want to camp BEFORE or AFTER the festival camping dates, please indicate this in the Additional Requests section in Part B.
 4. It is extremely important that all the requested information in Parts A, B and C be filled in accurately and completely. Missing or erroneous information will delay your camping request from being accepted/processed.
 5. **Email the completed Boogie Camping Form 2025(s)** per the instructions in Part D.
 6. We will acknowledge your Camping Registration Form once your completed Camping Registration Form(s) is received, the **camping costs** will be calculated per the 2025 Festival Camping Information and Fees (see page 3 below) and charged to your credit card. Also, additional Boogie tickets, if needed, will be charged separately to your credit card.
 7. Once your Camping Registration Form has been accepted and processed, you will receive in the mail, your parking pass, extra tickets, credit card receipt(s).

Camping Information

- ONE FORM FILLED OUT FOR EACH TENT, CAMPER, RV ON A GIVEN SITE
- Each camping reservation is for one (1) tent, Camper, RV
- Each reservation is for two (2) adults, and two (2) children 12 and under, and one motorized (1) vehicle
- Each numbered site or field site is limited to one (1) motorized vehicle. There is a charge for additional motorized vehicles on a site
- ALL people entering the campground MUST have a festival ticket; No ticket, No admission to the campground. Purchasing tickets are required prior to, or at the time of requesting camping reservations.
- For Field Camping, if you want to camp together with family & friends, arrive together.
- Should you want to camp BEFORE or AFTER the festival camping dates, please indicate this in the Additional Requests section in Part B.
 - For Field Camping: We will do our best to accommodate early arrival, however it is not guaranteed, since Field Camping doesn't open until Wednesday.

Festival Camping Information, Check-In and Rules

Check-In

Prior to your arrival on the campground road, Please;

- *have your tickets out and ready,*
- *have your parking pass filled out*
- *know your camping destination (site number or Field)*

When you arrive at the campground

- *drive slow (5mph) and pay attention to other vehicle and festival workers*
- *pay attention to traffic flow signs and festival worker directions to you*
- *relay all required information to the festival workers.*
- *stay in your vehicle, unless otherwise directed by a festival worker*

Be patient. There is a lot going on, and we want to make sure everyone gets to their campsite safely.

Camping Rules

- *Keep fire lanes open, DO NOT PARK in one.*
- *Always Display Car passes: on rearview mirror and facing forward*
- *No Fireworks please*
- *No firearms please*
- *Quiet time: 11pm – 7 am (NO Generators)*
- *No Visitors allowed during the festival*
- *No pets allowed, EXCEPT for registered Service Dogs*
- *Speed limit is 5mph. Please be considerate to the kids and families walking around the area*
- *Campfires confined to designated fire pits or approved above ground fire pits*
- *Tuesday check-in is 5pm-8pm. Wednesday – Saturday check-in 8am-8pm. No exceptions.*
